


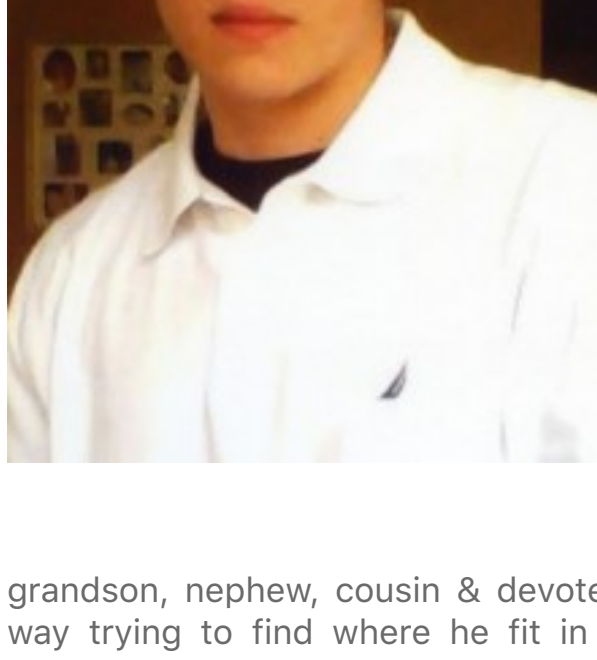




Ronald J. Renaud, Jr.
